



IMPORTANT SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The 2017/2018 school year application process for CEA and Brophy Scholarships will be available 02/01/2017. Every family who has a student (Kinder-8th) that will attend must complete the application for CEA and Brophy as well as 3 other STOs in order to attend.

CEA /FAIR- please apply online at <https://fairapp.com/Index.aspx>

When you create an account or sign in you will be asked for the school code and password. Enter 700 for the code and the password is cea700. During the application process you will be asked again for your school, at this point there will be a drop down menu where you will need to find our school listed as St. Joseph's Catholic School/Immaculate Conception. The deadline to complete this year will be 04/18/2017.

FAIR is the company that process applications for CEA, the cost to complete the application will be \$27.00, you can pay with a credit card during application process or mail in a check. The application will be processed upon receiving payment. Every family needs to complete the FAIR/CEA application (with the exception of families who are currently funded for 3 years by AAA). Only one application per family is needed, please make sure to include all of your children on the application.

FACTS is the company that process the application for BROPHY, the application fee is \$15 and \$30 if you apply after April 15, 2017. This application is only for those students that meet the criteria stated above. Family income will also be reviewed.

There will be a separate sheet shared with you with information and links to other scholarship opportunities and information on what documents are needed in order to successfully complete the applications. Please understand that it is important to complete the scholarships as soon as possible as they are on a first come first served basis. The longer you wait the less funding that may be available.

Also, please remember that your 2016 taxes should be filed before starting the application process in order for everything to go smoothly.
